**Hengyi Industries Sdn Bhd** is set to develop an Integrated Refinery and Aromatics Cracker Project on Pulau Muara Besar (PMB) in Brunei Darussalam. The investment amount for Phase 1 of the proposed Project is projected at US\$ 4 billion and will generate more than 1500 jobs in Brunei Darussalam.

We are inviting interested applicants to write in for the following vacant positions. The Job specifications and requirements are as follows:

## 1. Fire Prevention Management Senior Engineer (1 post)

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Assist the fire chief in on-site fire protection facilities, equipment supervision and inspection, maintenance and inspection work.
- Responsible for the company's fire protection design, formulate relevant management systems and standards, tracking, supervision, inspection and implementation.
- Responsible for the company's fire protection new or existing construction, technical transformation and other projects to obtain relevant qualifications
- Incharge of the procurement of on-site firefighting facilities and equipment
- Formulate management systems and plans
- Supervise the company's departments to regularly inspect fire-fighting facilities and equipment, and inspect fire-fighting pump rooms, fire monitors, fire hydrants, water pump adapters, fire-fighting facilities on tanks, alarm systems, and fire-fighting equipment to ensure that they are in good condition.
- Urge relevant departments to implement the rectification of hidden risk on time and report in accordance to regulations
- Organize the inspection of fire protection facilities and supervising the rectification of fire facilities.
- Assist in the review of the fire protection contents involved in the technical data such as the start-stop and test plan of the device, the accident handling plan, etc.
- .Participate in the discussion and implementation of the major fire hazard rectification plan supervision and management

◦ Requirements:

The successful candidate shall have a minimum of 6 years working experiences in petrochemical enterprises. Priority will be given to candidates who meets the following criteria:

- Holds a degree majoring in refinery or chemical engineering or fire protection
- Possess more than 6 years working experience in fire protection field, including 3 years of experience in fire protection in petrochemical enterprises
- Familiar with relevant fire policies, regulations, technical standards and specifications
- Strong organizational, coordination, analytical, problem-solving, and team leadership abilities
- Good language and writing skills.

## 2. Field Operator, Air Separation & Compression (1 post)

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Strictly abide by the technical specifications, job operation methods, and process cards in accordance to product quality indicators

- Cooperate with the internal operations and improve the product yield,
- Execute the internal operations and the instructions of the squad leader, complete the change process, switch the pump and other work as required
- Perform fixed-point, fixed-person, and scheduled on-site inspections, timely discover all kinds of problems on the site, and fill in the handover log;
- Implement the equipment maintenance and repair system and carry out routine maintenance work of spare machine pumps and large units as required
- Coordinate safety measures such as on-site fire and overhaul, equipment acceptance and commissioning and on-site sanitation and standardization requirement
- Implement safety critical equipment monitoring measures, during the shift found safety critical equipment abnormal state, cooperate with the inner master to adjust, record and analyze in a timely manner to eliminate hidden dangers.
- Optimize operational skills, increase product output, save energy and reduce consumption, save energy and reduce emissions

◦ Requirements:

The successful candidate shall have a minimum of 1 year working experiences in petrochemical industry. Priority will be given to candidates who meets the following criteria:

- Holds Diploma or above major in petrochemical engineering or related fields
- At least 1 year of production operation training or related work experience
- Proficiency in device process and operation skills, maintenance of equipment and equipment
- Possess strong production abnormality judgment and processing ability
- Good communication in English

### 3. Chief Operator, Instrument Maintenance (1 post)

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Carry out daily inspection of instrumentation equipment
- Participate in the daily duty shifting work of the team, perform the inspection and maintenance tasks of the instrument control equipment, and rectify or handle the self-inspection problems arranged by the team, and be responsible for the “three defenses” and on-site standardization of the instruments in the contracted area
- Replacement of important instrument components, power supplies, etc
- Carry out work in the new expansion and overhaul of the installation.
- Perform regular maintenance schedules and periodic calibration plans for instrument control equipment
- Responsible for daily maintaining and patrolling the instrument SCEs for equipment defects, and contacting related personnel for solution if defects are found, and reporting to the leaders when necessary

◦ Requirements:

The successful candidate shall have a minimum of 3 years working experiences in petrochemical industry. Priority will be given to candidates who meets the following criteria:

- Holds a Diploma or above major in petrochemical engineering or related fields
- Possess at least 3 years' experience in chemical production operation or related work experience
- Ability to do analysis, abnormal judgment and ability to handle instrumentation equipment failure
- Good communication in English
